The TECUnit, Inc. recommends that individuals who wish to take the Cued Language Transliterator National Certification Examination possess a thorough understanding of the Cued Language Transliterator Code of Conduct (©1989 Fleetwood & Metzger), the Code of Ethics of the Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf, Inc. (©1989 RID, Inc.), and the appropriate application of each to various interpreting/transliterating situations. Additionally, the TECUnit, Inc. recommends that said individuals possess a fundamental understanding of issues related to deaf and hard-of-hearing people and the Deaf community as well as knowledge which is equivalent to introductory course work in sociology, speech pathology, audiology, linguistics, and the profession of interpreting/transliterating between deaf/hard-of-hearing people and hearing people.

Each individual who wishes to take the Cued Language Transliterator National Certification Examination must sign this application to indicate that he/she has read, understands, and will abide by the specifications listed below.

All test material is considered confidential. Discussion or dissemination of actual test material is a violation of the testing procedure and will eliminate a CLTNCE candidate from consideration for certification and can serve as grounds for revoking any awarded certification.

Each Individual who is awarded certification is expected to subsequently function within the ethical and performance parameters defined by the responses and abilities he/she models at the time the CLTNCE is administered. This includes adherence to the Cued Language Transliterator Code of Conduct. Deviation from modeled or otherwise appropriate ethical and performance parameters can serve as a basis for revocation of the awarded certification.

A candidate for certification will receive the results of the CLTNCE within 90 days of the date the CLTNCE was administered, assuming he/she has completed the CLTNCE and complied with all examination-related procedures, policies and instructions. CLTNCE administration, evaluation, and scoring procedures are not open to review by anyone other than evaluators designated by the TECUnit, Inc.
